Admission is £5 per head for non RSI members payable on the evening, but advance booking is required to [events@royalsignals.org](mailto:events@royalsignals.org)

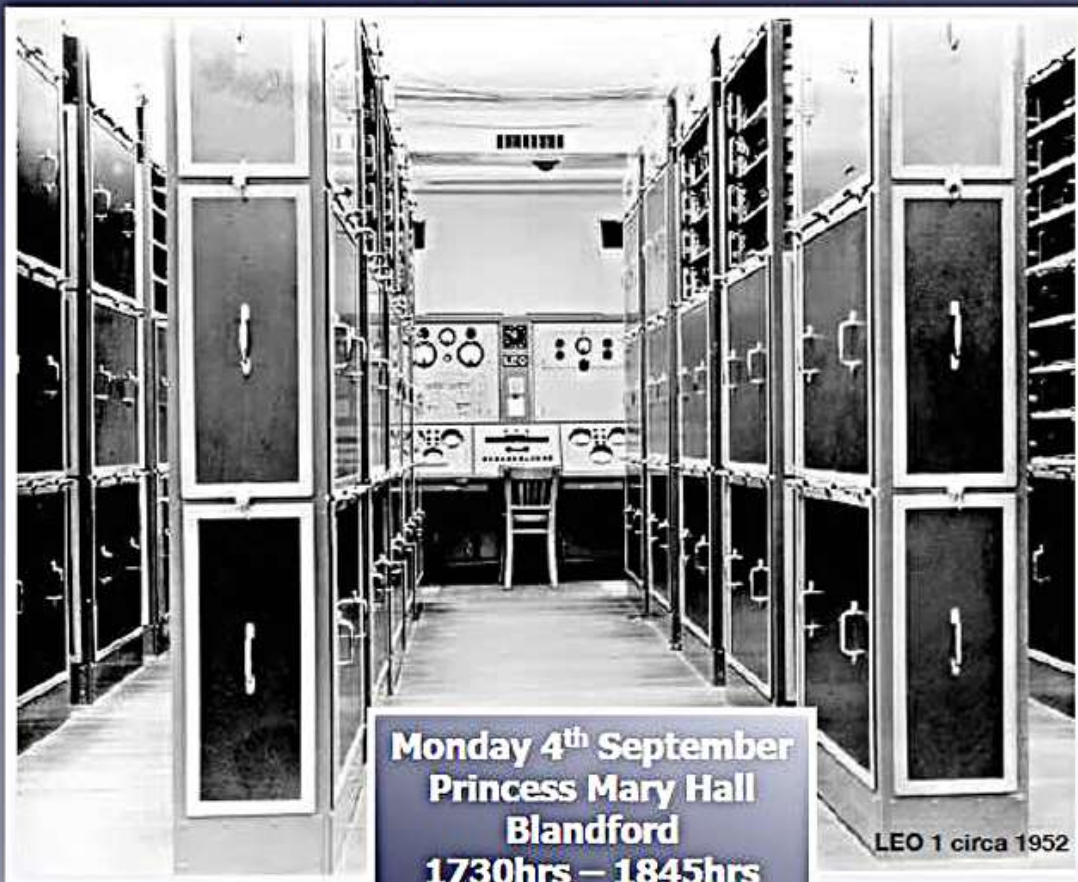
