It was on this site in 1951 that a British catering firm, J Lyons and Co - famous for their tearooms, Swiss rolls and ice cream - pioneered the development of computing for commercial applications. The world's very first business computer was designed and manufactured, not by one of the electronics giants such as IBM, but by J Lyons & Co.

After World War II higher costs made the company realise that some form of administrative automation was essential. There was nothing available at this time and so, with extraordinarily innovative spirit, they set about designing and building their own computer. They produced a working model in 2 years and called it LEO standing for Lyons Electronic Office. It achieved success and publicity beyond anyone's wildest dreams. 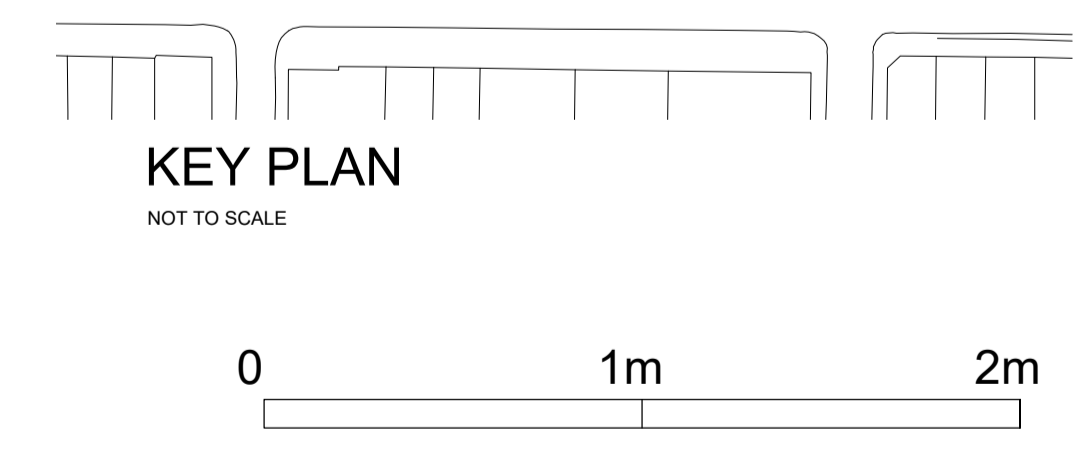
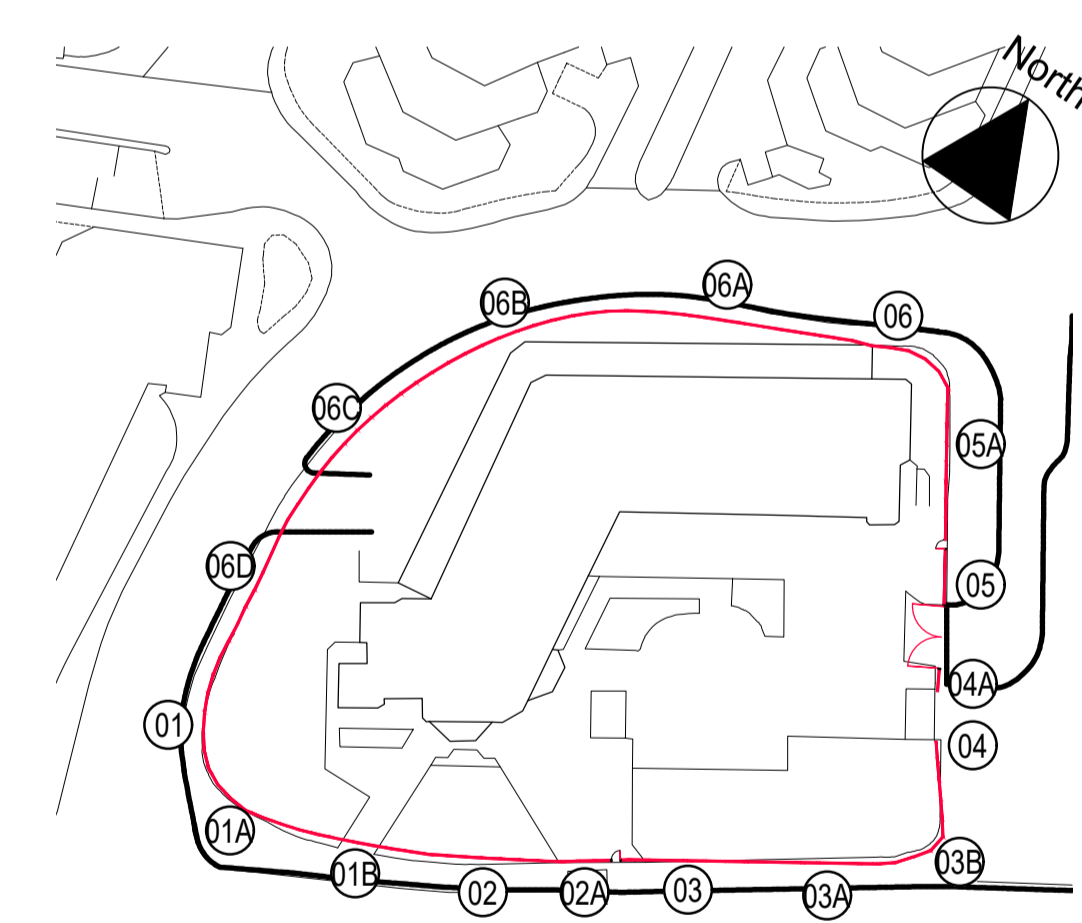
